01 COMMUNICATION

- Open and ongoing about risk of exposure.
- Be honest about where you go and who you see.
- Build community: Don't forget to check-in on how they and their loved ones are doing.



02 COLLECTIVE SAFETY

- Schedule work when no one is present.
- Provide hand sanitizer, mask, gloves and disinfectant.
- Provide good ventilation, by opening windows or doors.
- Find and facilitate safest transportation option.
- Commit to social distancing and masks in public.



03 BE THAT GREAT CLIENT

- Commit to fair pay adjusting compensation to account for extra work and/or risk level.
- Provide paid time off through Alia.
- Assist your worker in finding new work with strong recommendations.
- Consider an early holiday tip, 'gift cards' for future services and/or pay now for past cancellations.

04 PLAN FOR THE WORST CASE SCENARIO

- Provide resources on local access to health care, testing, and other emergency resources.
- Suspend work with pay if anyone is exposed to, experiences symptoms or tests positive for COVID-19.



05 STAY INFORMED

- Keep up to date on CDC guidelines.
